

Implementing BS 8901:2009

Training course description

- Explain the project management requirements for a BS 8901 implementation project, including resource and timescale calculations, relationship to events, ongoing requirement etc.
- Identify the range of specialist skills required by project manager and/or implementation team
- Describe the detailed requirements of the BS 8901:2009 standard
- Define the relationship between BS 8901:2009 (sustainability for events) ISO 14001:2004 (environmental management), ISO 9001:2008 (quality management) and BS OHSAS 18001:2007 (Health and Safety management)
- Outline practical steps for monitoring and measuring outputs at events
- Evaluate auditing practice, objective evidence and the emerging certification process
